As watching the sunset from the Temple of Poseidon is something you don't want to miss, we suggest an afternoon departure from Athens center. On your way back, and after sunset, you may combine dinner at "posh" hotel restaurants or traditional Greek Tavernas next to the sea.

1/2 Day Tour to Ancient Corinth (Duration approx 5 hours)

detailed guided tour at the ancient site of Mycenaes. Following, and after another 45 min

driving, you arrive at the Quaint of Nafplion, the capital of Greece before Athens. Enjoy your lunch there, and possibly try some of the best fried asparagus you have ever tasted. Following your lunch, 35 min driving from Nafplion, you arrive at the famous Ancient Theater of Asklepiou EPIDAVROS. Please read extensive details at

. Continuing, you will enjoy the guided tour of Epidavros (theater + museum) for approx 1 1/2 hours. Finally, drive back to Athens and your hotel, approx 3 hours driving.

Full Day Olympia Tour (Duration approx 14 1/2 hours)

You depart from the center of Athens, and after driving approx 1 1/5 hours you arrive at the canal of Corinth, uniting the Ionian and the Aegean Sea since 1893. You have 20 minutes for photos and rest. Driving time from Corinth to Ancient Olympia is approx 3 hours, and you can add 30 minutes here if you feel like visiting the St Andrews Cathedral, the patron-saint of Patras, located in the city center. Upon arrival at Olympia, we suggest a quick lunch at a local Greek Traditional Taverna for about 1 hour and then head for the Archaeological site and a 3 hour guided tour. After tour, we suggest 30 minutes walking at the main street of Olympian (shopping-walking) and then head back for Athens and your hotel.
